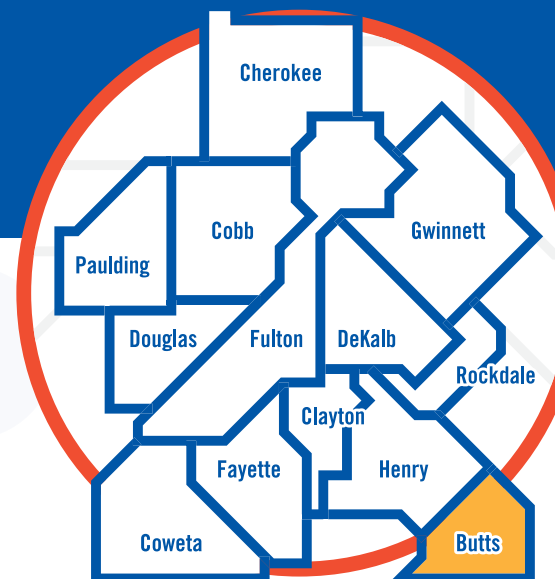

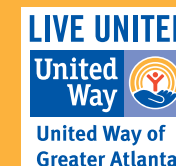

BUTTS LOCAL CONNECTION

To support parents and other family members of young students, United Way partnered up with the Butts County School System for a program called Parents As Teachers under the Parents Advancing Childhood Education (PACE) Initiative. **The program encourages parents to get more involved with their children's early education while providing the skills for parents to become leaders in their communities.** Since United Way introduced the program, Butts County has seen an increased parental participation, increased parental awareness of child development stages and improved parenting practices.

COMMUNITY HIGHLIGHTS

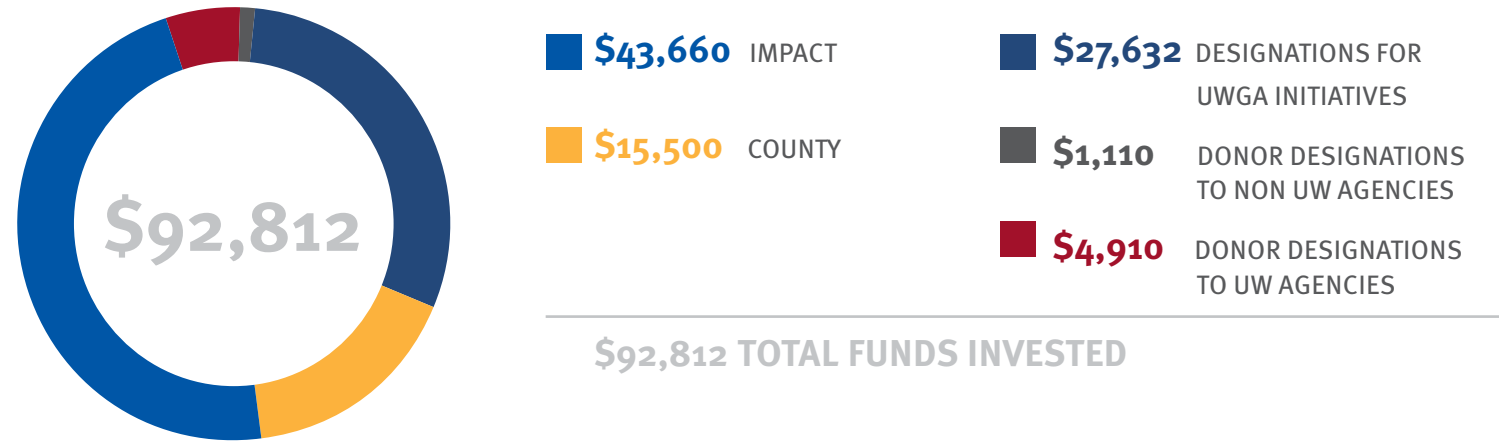
-  Overall, **2,873 individuals** were helped by United Way and its partners.
-  **917 individuals** received emergency financial assistance that enabled them to avoid homelessness and remain in safe and stable housing.
-  **113 children** showed academic improvement through combined education partnerships.
-  **202 older adults** who are safe, healthy, happy and able to remain in their homes via Support for Seniors.

Total Funds Invested For Fiscal Year 2015-2016

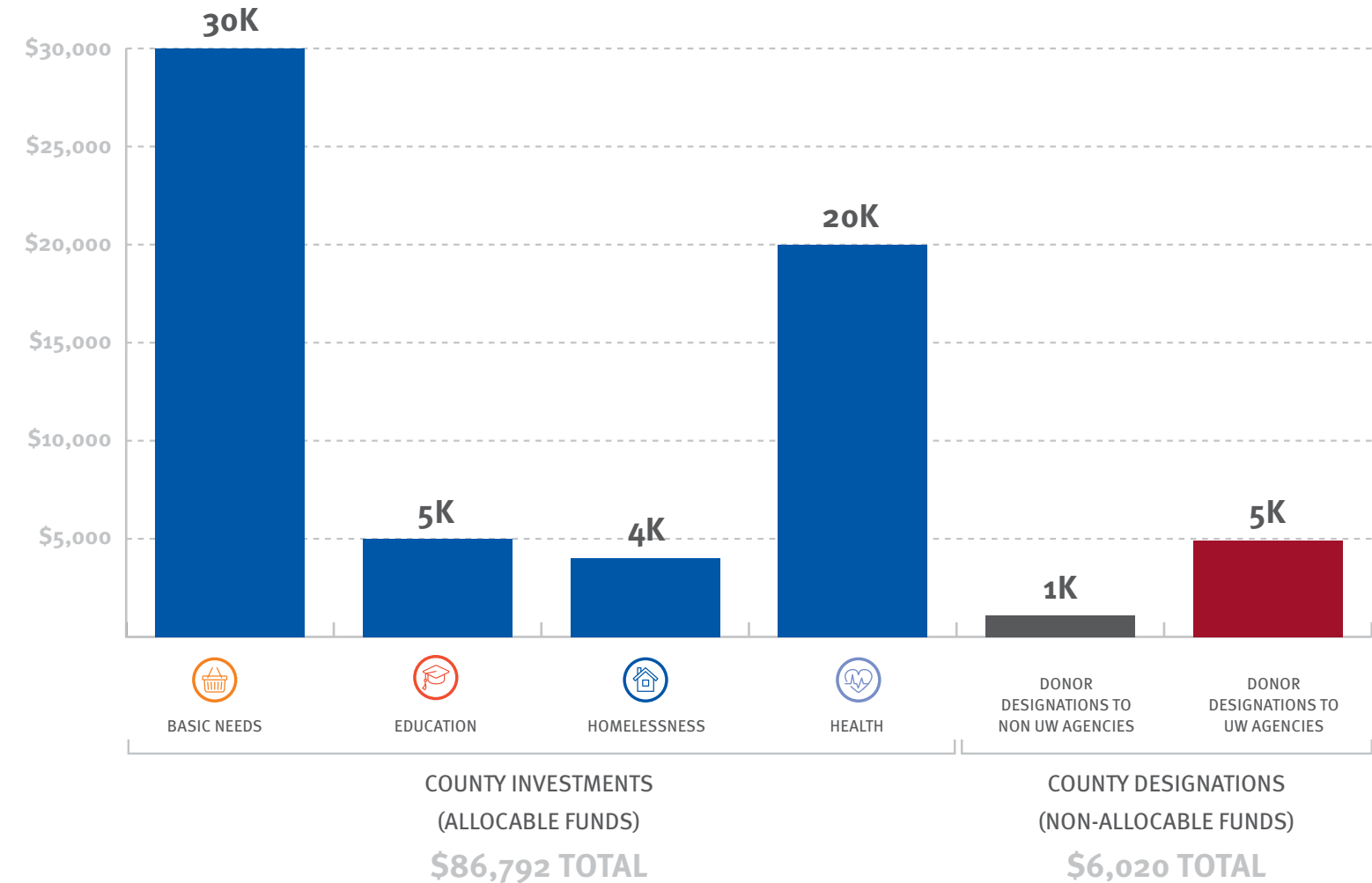


2-1-1 BUTTS COUNTY

Information obtained from our 2-1-1 Contact Center is critical to maintaining a connection to the needs of each community United Way serves. 2-1-1 connects people 24/7 to the resources they need to address the everyday challenges of living, as well as those that develop during times of emergencies. Last year 2-1-1 received 128 contacts from Butts County and the top 5 needs were **electrical service payment assistance (37)**, **rent payment assistance (33)**, **food pantries (23)**, **community shelters (22)** and **transitional housing shelters (13)**.
