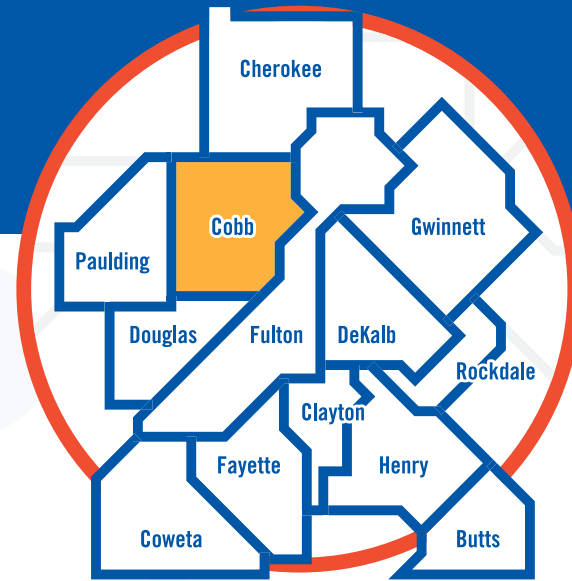

United Way partners with Marietta High School to support the Graduate Marietta Student Success Center. Last year, the program provided over 5,800 tutoring sessions, 84 students received mental health counseling, and 121 parents enrolled in English classes.

COMMUNITY HIGHLIGHTS

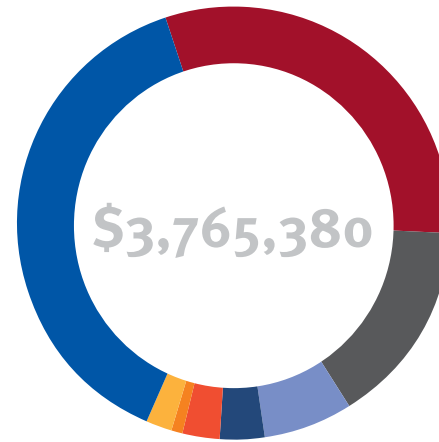
-  **33,829 individuals** were helped by United Way and its Partners in Cobb County.

Total Funds Invested For Fiscal Year 2015-2016



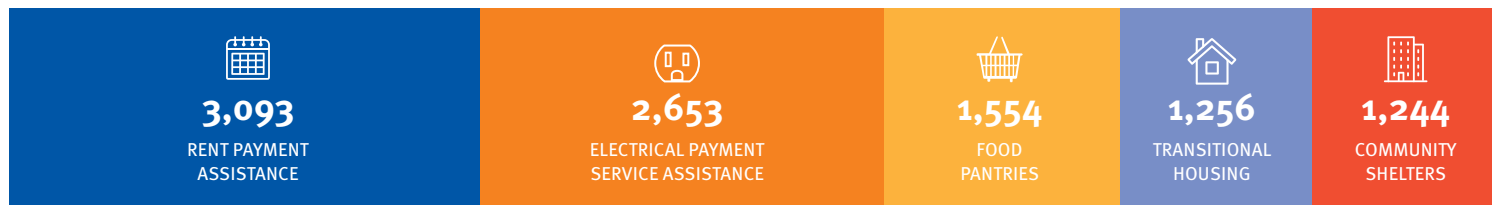

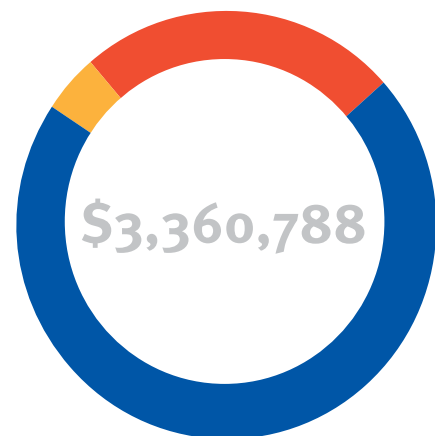


2-1-1 COBB COUNTY

Information obtained from our 2-1-1 Contact Center is critical to maintaining a connection to the needs of each community United Way serves. 2-1-1 connects people 24/7 to the resources they need to address the everyday challenges of living, as well as those that develop during times of emergencies. Last year 2-1-1 received 9,800 contacts from Cobb County and the top 5 needs were **rent payment assistance (3,093)**, **electrical service payment assistance (2,653)**, **food pantries (1,554)**, **transitional housing/shelter (1,256)**, and **community shelters (1,244)**.
