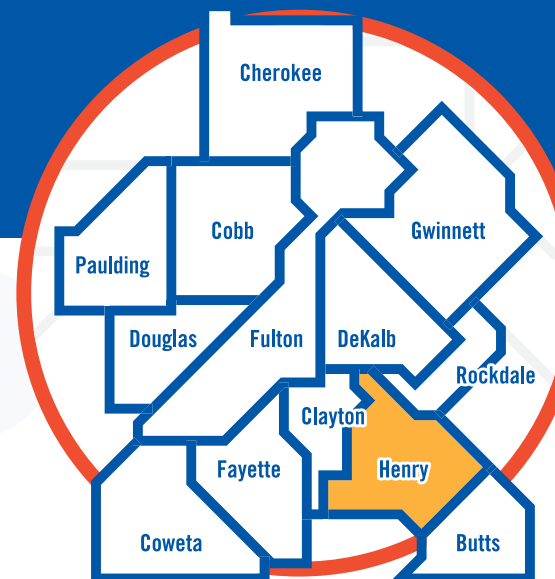

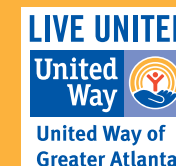

HENRY LOCAL CONNECTION


Since its launch date of April 2015, the Vets Connect initiative in Henry County has seen tremendous growth through the support of individuals and local businesses.


Now, there is more ongoing awareness of the needs of our veterans in the community, especially the ones who are homeless or on the verge of becoming homeless. Through local connections and partnerships, veterans are provided a safe place to stay temporarily until permanent housing can be secured; connected to local agency partners who provide food, clothing, job placement, financial literacy and help accessing their benefits.

COMMUNITY HIGHLIGHTS

 **6,805 individuals** were helped by United Way and its partners in Henry County.

 **2,833 children** showed academic improvement.

 **736 individuals** received in home nursing care and improved their health and ultimately avoid hospitalization.

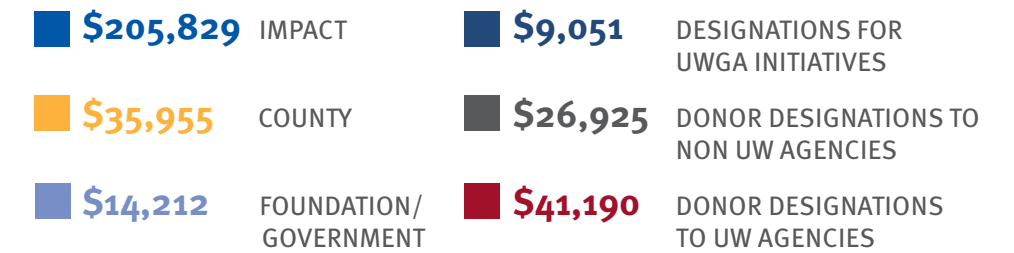
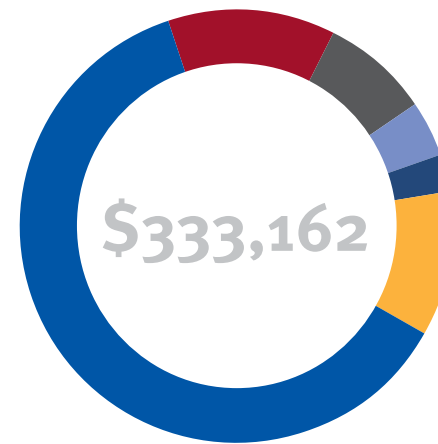
 **191 older adults** who are safe, healthy, happy and able to remain in their homes.

\$333,162 TOTAL FUNDS INVESTED

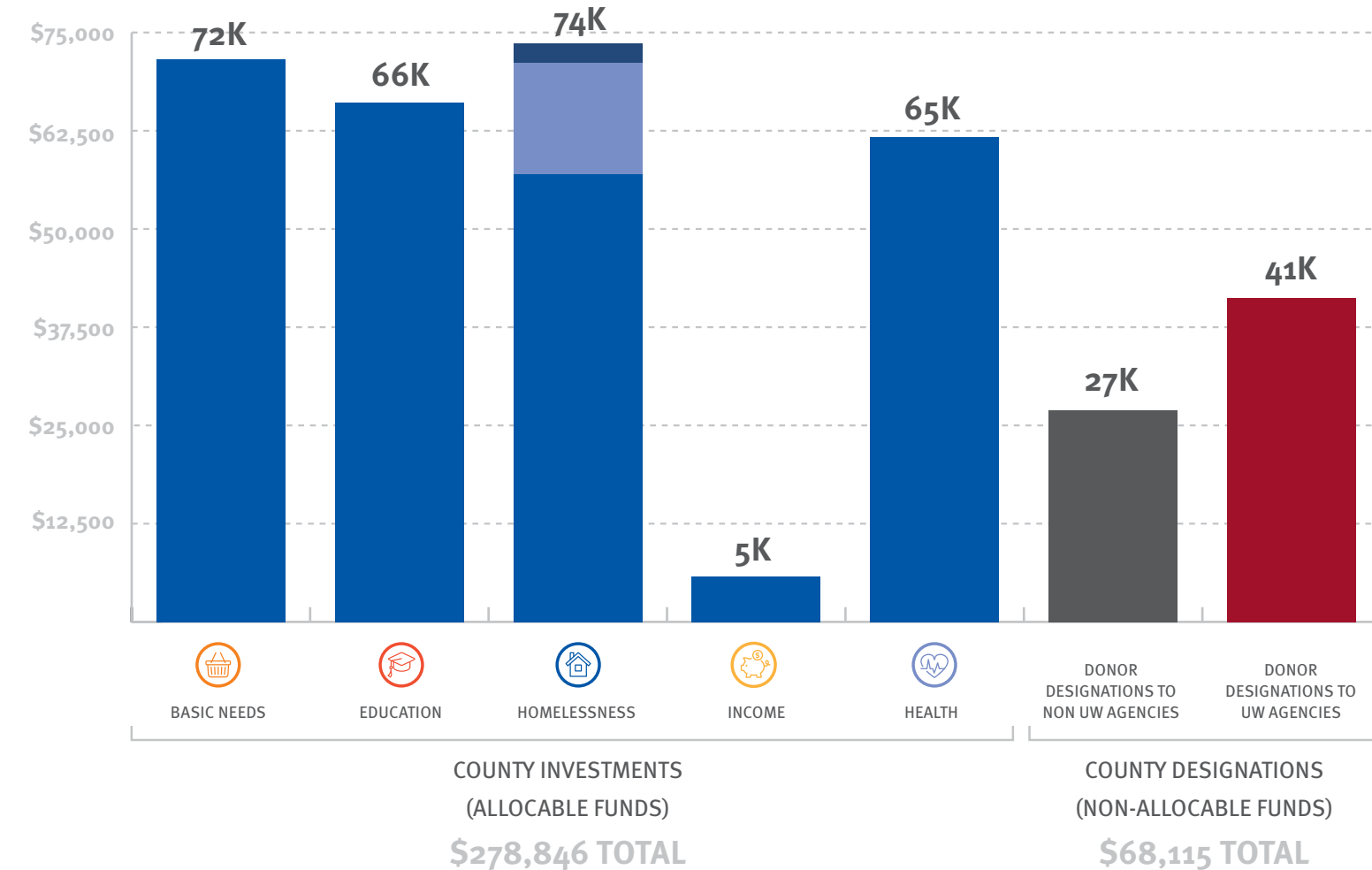


2-1-1 HENRY COUNTY

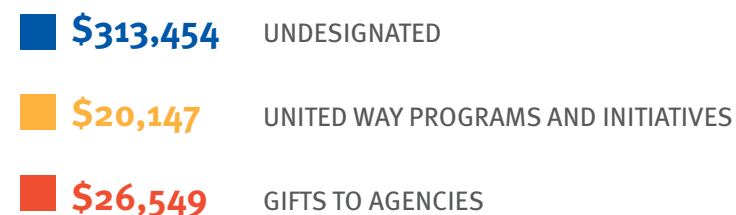
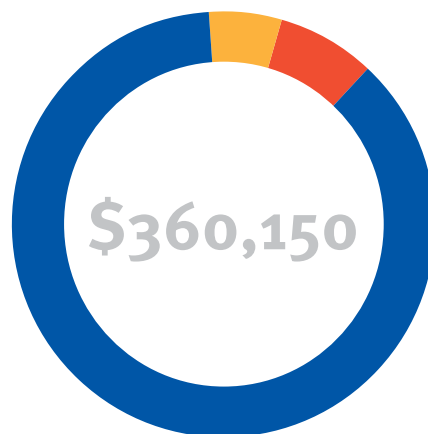
Information obtained from our 2-1-1 Contact Center is critical to maintaining a connection to the needs of each community United Way serves. 2-1-1 connects people 24/7 to the resources they need to address the everyday challenges of living, as well as those that develop during times of emergencies. Last year 2-1-1 received 2,543 contacts from Henry County and the top 5 needs were **rent payment assistance (863)**, **electrical service payment assistance (654)**, **food pantries (507)**, **transitional housing/shelter (291)**, and **community shelters (228)**.
