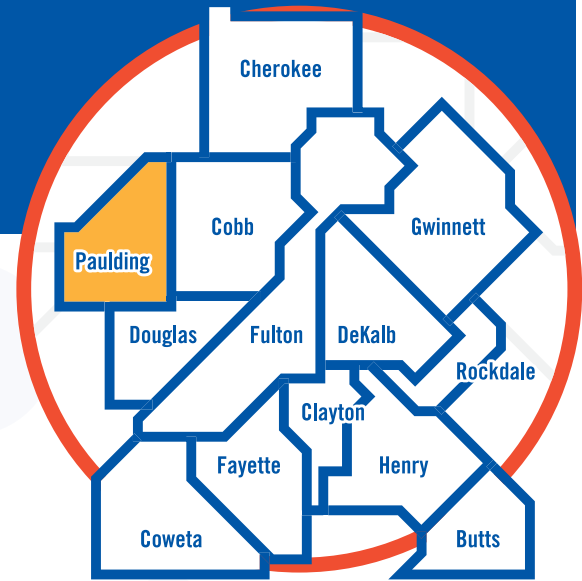

PAULDING LOCAL CONNECTION


CASA Paulding is an impressive example of a successful program supported by United Way.

In 2015, CASA served 288 children and volunteers donated 4,435 hours of service and drove over 30,000 miles to speak on behalf of abused and neglected children who are involved in the juvenile court system.

COMMUNITY HIGHLIGHTS

 **3,508 individuals** were helped by United Way and its partners in Paulding County.

 **1,259 children** showed academic improvement.

 **461 youth** who built leadership skills and are more committed to community service.

 **252 abused & neglected children** protected from further abuse and neglect.



2-1-1 PAULDING COUNTY

Information obtained from our 2-1-1 Contact Center is critical to maintaining a connection to the needs of each community United Way serves. 2-1-1 connects people 24/7 to the resources they need to address the everyday challenges of living, as well as those that develop during times of emergencies. Last year 2-1-1 received 729 contacts from Paulding County and the top 5 needs were **electrical service payment assistance (194)**, **rent payment assistance (193)**, **food pantries (130)**, **community shelters (109)**, and **holiday gifts/toys (103)**.

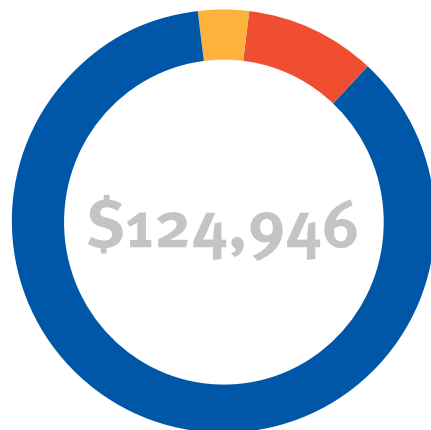

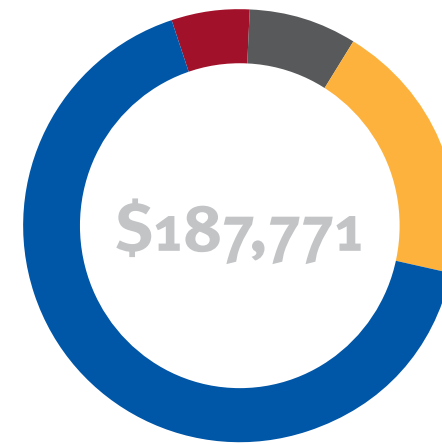
