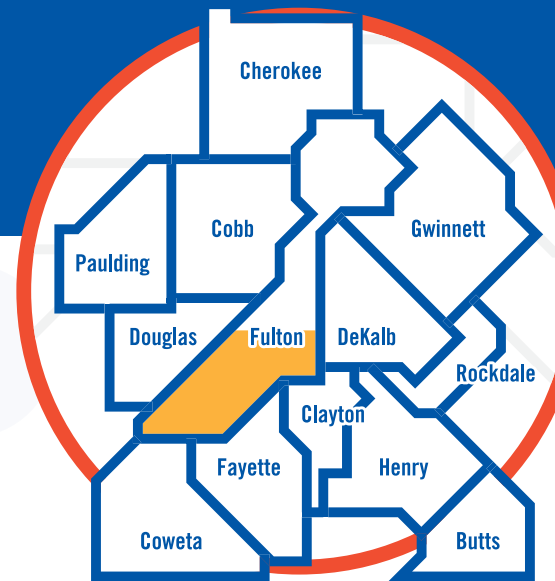

COMMUNITY HIGHLIGHTS*

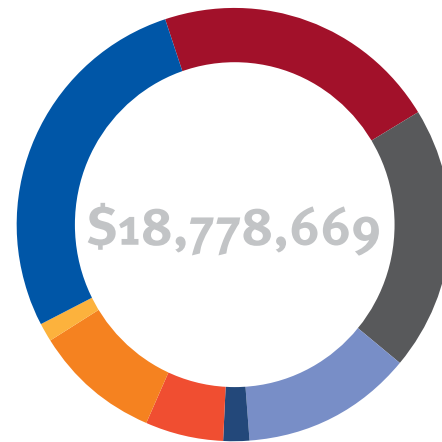
-  **9,988 individuals** were helped by United Way and its Partners in South Fulton County.
-  **1,515 children** showed academic improvement.
-  **105 individuals** remained in stable housing 90 days after receiving financial assistance.
-  **920 individuals** received in home nursing care and improved their health and ultimately avoided hospitalization.
-  **517 individuals and families** affected by disaster received emergency assistance.

Total Funds Invested For Fiscal Year 2015-2016



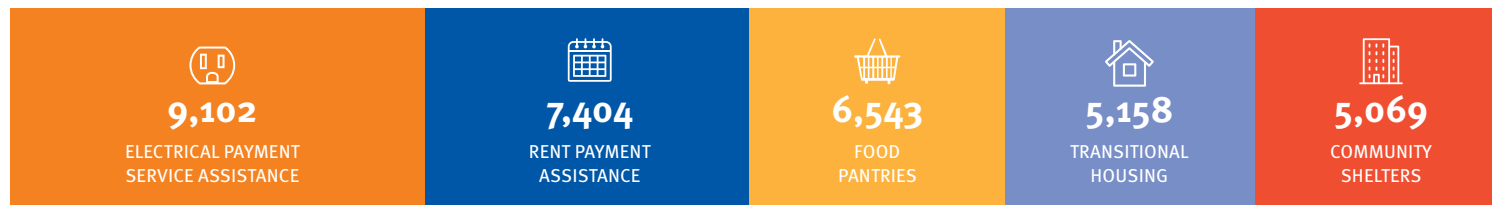

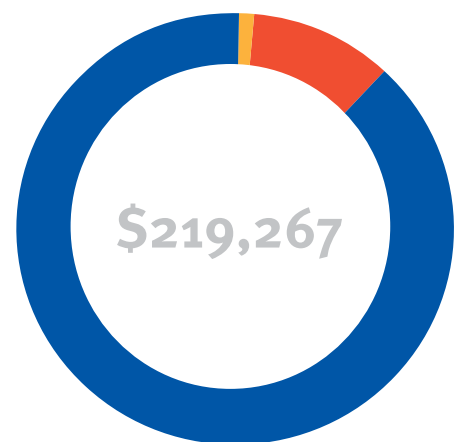


2-1-1 FULTON COUNTY

Information obtained from our 2-1-1 Contact Center is critical to maintaining a connection to the needs of each community United Way serves. 2-1-1 connects people 24/7 to the resources they need to address the everyday challenges of living, as well as those that develop during times of emergencies. Last year 2-1-1 received 33,276 contacts from Fulton County and the top 5 needs were **electrical service payment assistance (9,102)**, **rent payment assistance (7,404)**, **food pantries (6,543)**, **transitional housing/shelter (5,158)**, and **community shelters (5,069)**.
