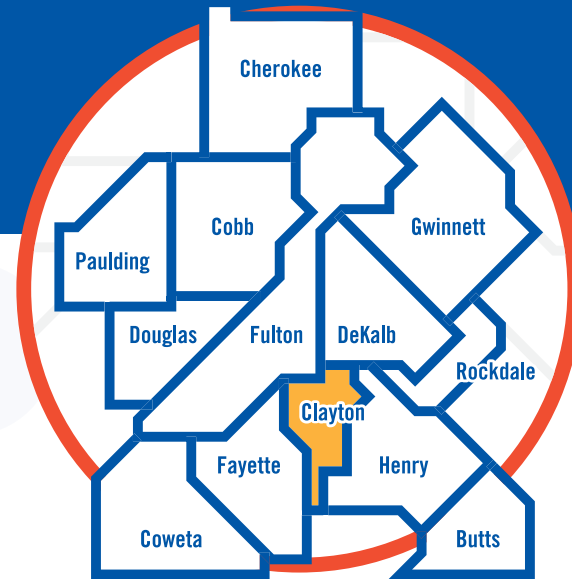

## COMMUNITY HIGHLIGHTS

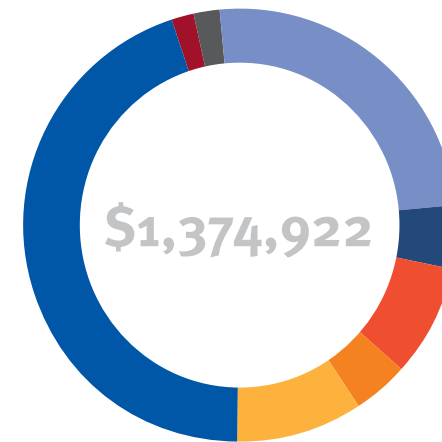
-  **14,471 individuals** were helped by United Way and its Partners in Clayton County.

### Total Funds Invested For Fiscal Year 2015-2016



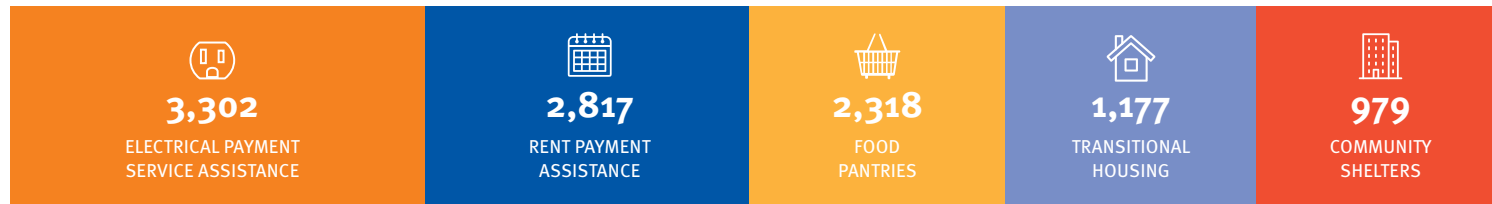

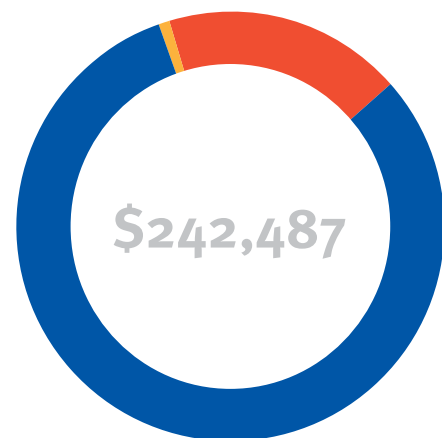


## 2-1-1 CLAYTON COUNTY

Information obtained from our 2-1-1 Contact Center is critical to maintaining a connection to the needs of each community United Way serves. 2-1-1 connects people 24/7 to the resources they need to address the everyday challenges of living, as well as those that develop during times of emergencies. Last year 2-1-1 received 7,984 contacts from Clayton County and the top 5 needs were **electrical service payment assistance (3,302)**, **rent payment assistance (2,817)**, **food pantries (2,318)**, **transitional housing/shelter (1,177)**, and **community shelters (979)**.
