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COMMUNITY SHELTERS

Programs, usually sponsored by community organizations or coalitions that provide temporary shelter for homeless people, generally in dormitory-style facilities with very little privacy. Most community shelters offer support services which may include counseling, advocacy, referrals and help with future plans; and enforce house rules including curfews and mandatory household chores. Participation in religious activities is either optional or not a part of the program. There may be differences in intake, length of stay and amenities in family oriented facilities and those that target other specific populations.

TRANSITIONAL HOUSING/SHELTER

Programs that provide extended shelter and supportive services primarily for homeless individuals and/or families with the goal of helping them live independently and transition into permanent housing. Some programs require that the individual/family be transitioning from a short-term emergency shelter. The length of stay varies considerably by program. It is generally longer than two weeks but typically 60 days or more and, in many cases, up to two years or more. The supportive services may be provided directly by the organization managing the housing or may be coordinated by them and provided by other public or private agencies. Transitional housing/shelter is generally provided in apartment style facilities with a higher degree of privacy than short-term homeless shelters; may be provided at no cost to the resident; and may be configured for specialized groups within the homeless population such as people with substance abuse problems, homeless mentally ill, homeless domestic violence victims, veterans or homeless people with AIDS/HIV. In some cases, a "transition in place" option allows families to continue living in the same complex (if not the same unit) where their transitional housing unit is located when they are ready to move to permanent housing. In other cases, the permanent housing option is either public housing or private rental housing supported by a tenant-based voucher subsidy. Included are post-domestic violence shelter housing programs that make affordable rental housing (or other accommodations) available to women, generally those who are coming directly out of a domestic violence shelter or other crisis shelter, often in apartment complexes owned by the shelter; and programs that provide transitional housing and support services for other targeted groups such as military and veteran families and others who need a temporary supportive living environment to maintain stability and begin to thrive.

Applying for a Georgia ID Card

HOW TO GET YOUR ID OR DRIVER'S LICENSE IN GA.

Any person that is old enough to sign their name, or make a mark indicating their legal signature can apply to the DDS for a identification card. You must provide acceptable proof of identification. You can apply for an identification card if your Georgia driver license is suspended or revoked. You do not have to surrender a Georgia identification card when you get a Georgia driver license or your Georgia driver license is reinstated.

1. Applicant must furnish proof that he or she resides in Georgia and must provide a valid Georgia residence address. The following items are acceptable:
 - Utility bill with valid Georgia residence address;
 - Bank statement with valid Georgia residence address;
 - Rental contracts and/or receipts with valid Georgia residence address;
 - Employer verification;
 - Georgia license issued to parent, guardian, or spouse.
2. Applicant must surrender all previous driver's licenses, identification cards, and instructional permits to the Examiner.
 - If applicant does not have in their possession, a license/ID card to surrender, must provide a certified copy of Motor Vehicle Report or status letter from previous state.
3. First time applicants for a Georgia license or permit or identification card must show some acceptable form of personal identification that includes full name, month, day and year of birth. After verification of full name and date of birth, documents will be returned immediately to the licensee. The following items are acceptable but **must be Original or a Certified Copy**:
 - Original birth certificate (State issued, Hospital birth certificates are not acceptable).
 - Certified copy of birth certificate (Issued from Vital Statistics with affixed seal)
 - Certificate of birth registration
 - Certified copy of court records (adoption, name changes or sex changes.)
 - Certified naturalization records
 - Immigration I.D. card
 - Valid Passport
4. Anyone applying for a Georgia driver's license or identification card must provide a social security number at the time of issuance. It is not necessary to have your original social security card. However, penalties will occur if an incorrect social security number is provided.

U.S. citizens must furnish proof of citizenship. Non-U.S. citizens must present proper INS documentation. Documents presented must be either in English or translated into English by a translator approved by the Department of Driver Services.

If you have NOT had a driver's license in another state, you do not need a "clearance letter" from that state, but if you have had a driver's license in any other state, even though you are applying for ID, you must get a clearance letter from that state. Can homeless people vote?

Yes. Any one who lives in Fulton County and who at the time of registration is not on probation for a felony is eligible to vote.

Why register to vote?

1. To exercise your right as a citizen to vote for issues and candidates of your choice.
2. Your voter registration card serves as a form of ID, and along with your social security card, it is sufficient to get your ID card or driver's license renewed at the GA Dept. of Public Safety. (If you have never had an ID card or driver's license in Ga., you must have your birth certificate; the voter registration card will not help you get your ID)

How long does it take to receive your voter registration card?

Most of the time you should receive your voter registration card within 7 business days after you apply. However, around election time, it may take longer. When you register, you should ask how long it would take for you to receive your card
